Introduction

Baptism

• Matthew 3:11 Mark 1:8 Luke 3:16 John 1:33 Acts 1:5 /11:16 All six references make a distinction between John's water baptism and Jesus baptizing in the Holy Spirit. • The Baptism of the Holy Spirit clearly happened in Acts 2:1-4

Acts 2

- The "Holy Spirit" baptism experience in Acts chapter 2 is the reference point for all of the book of Acts.
- Acts 8:15-17 / 10:44-47 / 11:15-16
 Acts 19:1-6

Acts 2

- Acts 2:1-4 All 120 were baptized in the Holy Spirit.
- Acts 2:5-11 Seventeen nations and languages were represented at Pentecost.
- The 120 manifested "Glossolalia" and "Xenoglossia".

Glossolalia

- Glossolalia is from the Greek word "glossa" meaning an unintelligible utterance.
- Translated as "unknown" tongue.
 "glossa" in Mark 16:17 Acts 2:4 Acts 10:45 | Corinthians 13:1 /14:14

Xenoglossia

 Xenoglossy or Xenoglossia is speaking a known language or dialect that has never been learned, understood or spoken. Acts 2:7 "Each one heard them speaking in his own language." • The Greek word is "dialectos".
